She's JEFFRY ARMSTRONG, wife of Ralph Armstrong, AWSA senior boat driver and mother of Raif and Cali, both excellent skiers in their own right. She and her family live and ski in Grenada, Miss., where Jeffry has her own business. Involved in tournament skiing for 18 years and winner of many trophies, Jeffry feels her greatest prize is the lasting friendships she has made through AWSA. In 1963 at the Jackson, Miss. Open, Jeffry began work on that infamous "yellow sheet" . . . asst. judges form. She credits Pete Salassi, Frank Kokenes, Jessie Rambo, Cecil Herron and Monroe Scurlock for much help and understanding. In October of 1968, she became the youngest Sr. judge in AWSA's history. From there she's gone on to represent our region in several national judging positions and committees and currently as our EVP and director. She also serves on the Rules Committee and has worked to save left sided jumping.

Equally as noteworthy as her judging and administrative accomplishments, is Jeffry's skiing. Participant in many nationals and winner of several Miss. State Championships (not to mention countless other trophies along the way) Jeffry cites two "wins" as being most special to her: 1977 Regionals, in which she and daughter Cali both won Overall in their division; and the 1977 Correct Craft Outstanding Skier Award. With a best jump of 98 feet, Jeffry's skiing goal is membership in the Century Club. In her own words, "Not too many old women do that!!"

IMPORTANT NEW SCR RULES

Approved at Mid Winter Meeting in Tyler

1. Tournament earned Expert rating required for all divisions that had 27 or more skiers in last years Regionals and 1st class for all other divisions. For 1979, Expert rating will be required for Men I & Men II.
2. For two day sanctioned tournaments, contestants shall be limited to 125 with the sponsoring club option to limit the size of any division. If novice is run in conjunction with the tournament, 125 is still the maximum allowed.
3. Regionals shall be seeded by ratings, including EP. It is the skier's responsibility to turn in his rating card for seeding.

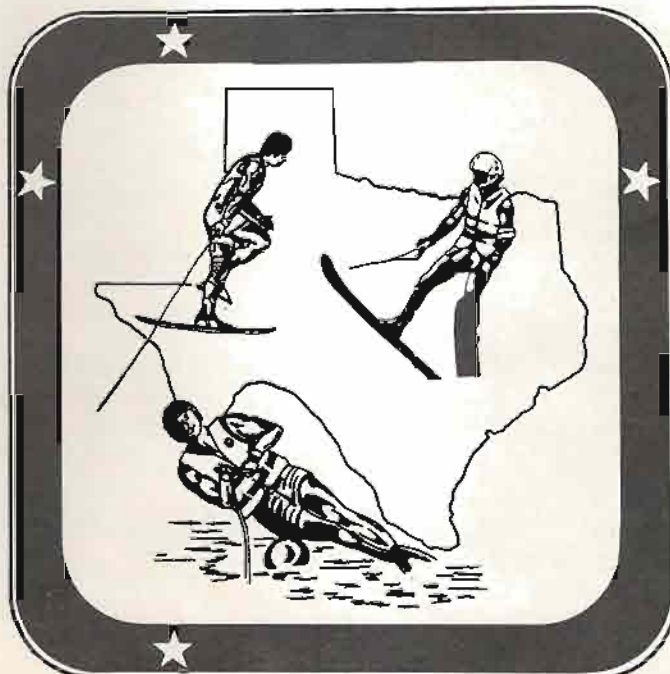

EP skis dominate tournament skiing for the seventh straight year.



- EP skis won 72% of all the 1st place prize money in the 1978 Pro Circuit, including a Grand Slam in the Marine World Tour, Dallas International Jump Classic, Iron Man Tour and 67% of the 1st places in the Cal-Cup.
