AWSA Board of Directors' Meeting Denver, Colorado ♦ January 23, 1982

A. NATIONALS QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Open Division skiers may skip their Regionals in order to ski in an AWSA- or WWSU-sanctioned cash prize tournament *only if* the Regional Tournament is held on a weekend other than the third weekend prior to the Nationals.
2. Skiers seeking medical excuse from their Regionals must report in person to their EVP at the Regional Tournament. The EVP will then decide whether to grant a medical excuse. This includes skiers injured prior to or during the Regional Tournament.
3. No Regional excuses will be granted for the following reasons:
a) hospital stay, b) religious, c) business, d) personal
4. Interpretation: In Rule 4.05, the amount of skiing done in a Region applies to actual time on the water.
5. Interpretation: In Rule 4.08, to have competed in a Regional Tournament, a skier must have attained skiing position in that event.
6. A \$5.00 non-refundable filing fee will be made part of (not in addition to) the Nationals entry fee.

B. RULES:

1. Jumping Speed for Open Women was raised to 32 mph (51 kph).
2. The following series of ski line tricks was added:

Trick Description:

1. Both feet must pass over the line while in midair.
2. The feet may pass over the line at any point during the execution of the turn.
3. The portion of the line that the feet pass over must be out of the water during the execution of the turn.
3. All four toehold wake line tricks were separated under different trick numbers and can be performed in the same pass.
4. The point value of wake flips will be raised 50 points if a proposed action to do so by the WWSU is approved.
5. Open Division skiers will be required to follow a declared trick list. A maximum of 35 tricks may be listed for any single pass. If noted in the tournament announcement, a sponsor may elect to require other divisions to follow declared trick lists as a Rule 13 exception in Class C-A tournaments.
6. For all tournaments, use of an 18.25-meter line below maximum speed in slalom is now at the option of the skier. At maximum speed, if the skier makes a perfect pass he receives credit for both the 23-meter and the 18.25-meter line pass. If the pass is missed, he will receive credit for buoys as if it were the 23-meter pass.
7. Neophyte tricks were eliminated from Rule 13.
8. Unless stated in the tournament announcement, a skier in a multi-round tournament need not ski all rounds to be considered for placement. Not skiing in a round constitutes a score of zero for the round.
9. Sponsors of Record Capability tournaments other than Regionals or Nationals may elect to use 1,000-point overall scoring (for overall skiers only) instead of NOPS as a Rule 13 exception *if* it is so stated in the tournament announcement.

C. TECHNICAL:

1. The total length of the jump timing course was shortened from 93 meters to 87 meters by moving the first timing buoy closer to the ramp. Also, the 180-meter cut-out buoy was established as the jump course entry buoy.
2. Cylindrical buoys will be allowed for interior boat guide buoys in slalom contingent upon a similar ruling by the WWSU.
3. The 14-meter ("45-foot") boat guide buoy and the corresponding timing course exit buoy in the jumping course may be sunk more than half way to help eliminate torn-out buoys.
4. To cut down on rerides on bunks in jumping, .05 seconds will be added to the boat time to compensate for the surge in boat speed when the line is released.
5. The tolerance for speeds below maximum in jumping will be spread approximately one mile per hour.
6. The "seventh loop" (10.75 meters) in slalom will be added to the line shortening schedule. The color of the loop to be white.


