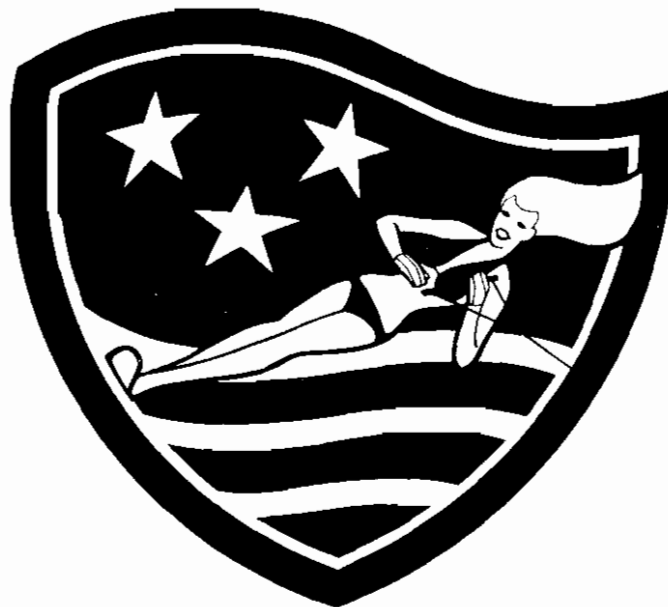

1983 National Winter Meeting and Review

A. Executive & Finance Committee:

1. The contract with IMG was not renewed — a task force committee will be formed to make recommendations for improvement.
2. AWSA has purchased 2 Apple computers.
3. World Water Ski Association is trying to get a financial audit.

B. International Committee Activities:

1. June 25 & 26 the Team Trials will be held at McCormick's Lakes.
2. The officials were approved and the same criteria to select the team will be used as before. The third round of the Trials will be the 1983 Nationals.

C. Tow Boat Study:

1. An annual tow boat evaluation day will be held.
2. Eight (8) Manufacturers participated in this year's evaluation.

D. Boat Driver Rating & Classification:

1. Concerned with approval of promotions.
2. Recommendations of the committee:
 - a. Full credit will be given for the Collegiate Regional and National Tournaments.
 - b. Discontinue specified number of pull for an event (now one pull equals an event).
 - c. Drivers turned down for either of the above will be reconsidered for promotion.
 - d. Chief Driver of Nationals being selected by the President of AWSA (as the Chief Judge and Chief Scorer are) instead of the method being used now was discussed. The only requirement would be to be a Senior Boat Driver.

E. Technical Committee:

1. The multi-colored lines were approved.
2. Cylinder gates were approved except for Record Tournaments.
3. The new handles submitted for approval were disapproved.
4. The turning of the ramp needs to be further studied before a decision can be reached.

F. Skier's Rating Committee:

1. New ratings will go into effect as of 1983 Nationals.
2. EP and Open Ratings will be on one form.
3. NOPS tables will be based only on the performances of overall skiers — standards to be determined by the top 25% of the 3 event skiers in the Nationals from the 2 previous years — effective August 17, 1983.
4. Ties at Regionals and Nationals:
 - a. 4th place ties in Nationals will not be run off and all ties will go to the Nationals the next year, provided the skiers have valid Master ratings, only 1st place ties will run off.
 - b. If necessary for purpose of National Tournament qualification, ties in fourth places shall be run off at Regional Tournaments.

G. Bylaws Committee:

Research will be conducted to recommend some new guidelines for the Tommy Dorwin and Fred Wiley awards.

H. Extras:

1. 32 mph jumping for Sr. Men and Vet. Men was tabled.
2. Single Event Judges were disapproved.
3. Two tow boats for Nationals was approved.
